Windshield Repair

You don't have to replace your windshield because of a stone chip. Many small dings and cracks in your windshield can be repaired in as little as 30 minutes, leaving your factory installed windshield in place.

WHY REPAIR INSTEAD OF REPLACE?

Safety – Your original windshield is a vital safety component. A properly installed windshield helps airbags deploy in an accident while keeping you and your passengers in the vehicle

Convenience – Repairs usually take less time than replacements because the windshield is not removed. Since the original factory seal is not broken, there are fewer wind, water and rust problems

Technology – Modern windshields may contain electronics such as antennas and rain sensors. To avoid potential problems, it always makes sense to keep the original windshield in your car

Environment – Most windshields are not recycled. Repairs are environmentally friendly because your windshield does not end up in a landfill









Small windshield star breaks, bulls-eyes and cracks less than 6 inches can often be repaired by injecting a special resin into the damage and curing it under ultraviolet light.

This process bonds any loose glass and prevents the damage from spreading. If your windshield damage is small and looks like this, there is a good chance it should be repaired.







A FEW SIMPLE STEPS CAN HELP SAVE YOUR WINDSHIELD:

Report any glass damage as soon as possible, no matter how small. Cold weather and normal vehicle operation can cause the damage to spread quickly making a repair impossible.

Pick a windshield repair expert to fix the glass damage. Not all glass technicians are trained to repair windshields. Make sure you choose a glass shop that has trained windshield repair experts on staff.
